

LAWS ABOUT THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS IN THE TOWN OF PAWLEYS ISLAND

---

1. The driver must be at least 16 years old and must be in possession of a valid driver's license, the registration certificate issued by the South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles (SCDMV), and proof of liability insurance for the golf cart.
2. Golf Carts shall comply with all traffic rules and regulations and parking laws.
3. The address on the registration must be within 2 miles of the town limits located on the North or South Causeway.
4. A golf cart cannot be driven on any street from sunset to sunrise. Golf carts are only permitted on streets during daylight hours.
5. The driver of a golf cart shall use hand signals when turning or stopping unless the golf cart is equipped with turn signals.
6. A golf cart must have current decals from SCDMV and the Town of Pawleys Island that are displayed in a clearly visible location on the golf cart.

CERTIFICATION BY OWNER
