



BENEFITS OF USACE PROJECT

50 Year project

- Initial Renourishment
- Four 9-year periodic renourshments
- One 5-year renourishment
- USACE section fully federally funded up front
- Town will be given 30 years to repay their share of costs (35%)
- Future storm damage may qualify for 100% federal rehabilitation costs under the authority of PL 84-99

 Acquire Real Estate easements from 113 properties in federal project (End of April)

 Acquire Right-of-entry agreements from 116 properties in betterment project (End of May)
