

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-07

AN ORDINANCE  
SECTION 2-224

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAWLEYS ISLAND

INTENT

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide clarification as to the procedure used by the Town of Pawleys Island on the Town's annual audit and required reporting thereafter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAWLEYS ISLAND, SOUTH CAROLINA, PURSUANT TO THE SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS 1976 (AS AMENDED) THAT THE ORDINANCE SHALL READ:

Sec. 2-224. - Annual audit.

(a) Required. The town council shall provide for an annual audit of all town financial records and transactions. The council may, without requiring competitive bids, designate such accountant or firm annually or for a period not exceeding three years, provided that the designation for any particular fiscal year shall be made no later than 30 days after the beginning of such fiscal year. The accountant or firm of accountants shall not have personal interest, direct or indirect, in the fiscal affairs of the town or any of its officers.

(b) Report. The report of the audit shall be filed in the office of the clerk/treasurer as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection.

This Ordinance shall take effect and amend Chapter 2 of the Code Section 2-224 and be in full force after the date of its adoption by the Town Council of the Town of Pawleys Island.
