

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-09

AN ORDINANCE  
SECTION 2-270

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAWLEYS ISLAND

INTENT

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide clarification as to the procedure used by the Town of Pawleys Island in contracting for professional service contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAWLEYS ISLAND, SOUTH CAROLINA, PURSUANT TO THE SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS 1976 (AS AMENDED) THAT THE ORDINANCE SHALL READ:

Sec. 2-270. - Professional service contracts.

(a) Authority. For the purpose of procuring any professional services, where the person or firm employed is customarily employed on a fee basis rather than by competitive bidding, the town may act as a purchasing agent and contract on its own behalf for such services without the necessity of complying with the provisions of the competitive procurement requirements.

(b) Administrator recommendation; council approval. The administrator shall recommend the person or firm to the town council for approval as soon as possible. If approved by the town council, such contract may thereafter be entered into.

This Ordinance shall take effect and amend Chapter 2 of the Code Section 2-270 and be in full force after the date of its adoption by the Town Council of the Town of Pawleys Island.




