

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-10

AN ORDINANCE
SECTION 2-272

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAWLEYS ISLAND

INTENT

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide clarification as to the procedure used by the Town of Pawleys Island in contracting for a supply, service, or construction item in which there is only a single source available.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAWLEYS ISLAND, SOUTH CAROLINA, PURSUANT TO THE SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS 1976 (AS AMENDED) THAT THE ORDINANCE SHALL READ:

Sec. 2-272. - Sole-source procurement.

A contract may be awarded for a supply, service or construction item without competition when the administrator or designee determines in writing that there is only one source for the required supply, service or construction item. After such written determination has been made, all sole-source contracts not exceeding \$3,000.00 may be entered into without the necessity of complying with the provisions of this article. For all sole-source contracts exceeding \$3,000.00, the administrator shall recommend such contracts to the town council for approval as soon as possible. If approved by the town council, such contract may thereafter be entered into.

This Ordinance shall take effect and amend Chapter 2 of the Code Section 2-272 and be in full force after the date of its adoption by the Town Council of the Town of Pawleys Island.
