

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-12

AN ORDINANCE
SECTION 2-276

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAWLEYS ISLAND

INTENT

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide clarification as to the authority of the Purchasing Agent to act on behalf of the Town of Pawleys Island in transferring stock or surplus supplies to other offices, departments, or agencies of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAWLEYS ISLAND, SOUTH CAROLINA, PURSUANT TO THE SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS 1976 (AS AMENDED) THAT THE ORDINANCE SHALL READ:

Sec. 2-276. - Surplus stock.

(a) The administrator shall have authority to transfer stock or surplus supplies to other offices, departments or agencies of the town.

(b) If the administrator deems it appropriate, surplus stock and supplies can be given to charity, another public entity or may be sold without formal advertisement of competitive procedures for items with an estimated value up to \$500.00.

(c) If deemed appropriate and approved by town council, surplus stock and supplies may be auctioned off to the highest bidder at an auction that has been noticed in a paper of general circulation. Written bids will be accepted on all surplus stock and supplies that have been listed in the auction bulletin. The auction bulletin shall describe each item and its fair market value. Employees, council-members and their immediate families are not eligible to bid on auction items.

This Ordinance shall take effect and amend Chapter 2 of the Code Section 2-276 and be in full force after the date of its adoption by the Town Council of the Town of Pawleys Island.


