**A Resolution Adopting the Town of Pawleys Island
Flood Mitigation and Drainage Master Plan**

WHEREAS, The Town of Pawleys Island recognizes that the regular occurrence of flooded roadways and private property during King Tide cycles and other weather events as a long-term threat to the community; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Pawleys Island received a grant through the SC Rural Infrastructure Authority to initiate a Flood Mitigation and Drainage Master Plan process to address these issues; and

WHEREAS, The Flood Mitigation and Drainage Master Plan includes a detailed assessment of the existing conditions of the existing infrastructure on Pawleys Island; and

WHEREAS, The Flood Mitigation and Drainage Master Plan identifies needed improvements to the drainage infrastructure on Pawleys Island based on modelling that considers a combination of sea level rise projections and severe weather conditions; and

WHEREAS, The Flood Mitigation and Drainage Master Plan includes cost estimates for each of the recommended phases of infrastructure improvements providing a strategic framework to secure funding to begin this important work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council does hereby officially adopt the Town of Pawleys Island Flood Mitigation and Drainage Master Plan as a critical guidance document to implement improvement projects to address the ongoing flooding and drainage issues on the island.


