A Resolution Adopting the Assessment of the North Jetty Summary Report

WHEREAS, The Town of Pawleys Island acknowledges the importance of the North Jetty structure as a shoreline stabilization and erosion control feature along Midway Inlet on the Northern end of Pawleys Island; and

WHEREAS, The North Jetty was built in the early 1950s primarily with support from the South Carolina Highway Department; and

WHEREAS, The structural components of the North Jetty are exhibiting signs of deterioration compromising the integrity of the structure and making the northern end of the island vulnerable during severe tropical storm events and long-term sea level rise impacts; and

WHEREAS, By recognizing the importance of examining the condition of the North Jetty and to develop recommendations for repairing and upgrading the structure, the Town of Pawleys Island commissioned Coastal Science and Engineering to perform a condition assessment study of the North Jetty.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council does hereby officially adopt the Assessment of the North Jetty Summary Report as a technical guidance document to pursue structural improvements and to properly ensure the long-term functionality of the North Jetty is maintained.
